Union Territory of Puducherry Legal Services Authority initiated a Legal Services Clinic at Bharathidasan Govt. College for Women on 29.3.2016 in order to cater legal services for women students for free of cost and to disseminate legal awareness among girl students. It was inaugurated by Thiru. N.Sivakumar, Presiding officer, Industrial Tribunal – cum –Labour court, Puducherry, Mrs.Malarvizhi, Principal Sub Judge and Secretary, District Legal Service Authority ,Puducherry and the Principal of the college Dr. Sasi Kanta Dash.

Dr.S.Alamelu Mangai, Assistant Professor,PG & Research dept. of Home Science was nominated as Chairman of Legal Services Clinic of the college and Ms.Trishla .S.Jain, II B.Com as Student Member of the Clinic. The clinic renders free legal services and counseling every 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of the month with the help of Mrs. N. Bazira kanny ,Advocate from UTPLSA, Puducherry.

Every month students grievances were addressed personally and the remedies to be taken legally were rendered. A total of 528 students were benefitted through legal service clinic of the college during the year 2016-2017.

***REPORT of the seminar on LEGAL EMPOWERMENT of WOMEN- 28.3.2017***

Bharathidasan Government College for women (Autonomous), Puducherry and Union Territory of Puducherry Legal Services Authority (UTPLSA) jointly organized RUSA sponsored one day **Regional Seminar on Legal Empowerment Women** on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2017 in the College Auditorium. Tmt.

S.Ramathilaga, Chief judge ,Puducherry, was the chief guest, Dr. G. Narendra Kumar, I.A.S Development Commissioner –cum- Secretary (Education),Puducherry inaugurated the seminar.

The Seminar began with Registration of the student participants followed by Invocation and Lighting of the Kuthuvilaku . Dr.P.Poongavanam, Principal, BGCW delivered the welcome address while Dr.Rajiny Chanolian, Coordinator presented the theme of the seminar and Dr. G. Narendra Kumar,I.A.S delivered the inaugural address. He shared his experiences when at Delhi as Secretary, Ministry of Women and Child Development where he rendered services and implemented several schemes for the welfare of women and children, especially legal counseling in conjunction with NALSA.Thiru G. Sendilkumar, Secretary to Government (Law) Puducherry, Tmt. V. Sofana Devi, District Judge, Member Secretary, Union Territory of Puducherry Legal Services Authority, Thiru Yasam Lakshmi Narayana Reddy, Additional Secretary to Government (Home), Puducherry & Director of Higher & Technical Education felicitated the conduct of the seminar. Chief Judge Tmt. S. Ramathilagam delivered the presidential address wherein she pointed out the importance of women at workplace and at home. The leadership qualities of the women should be garnered with education, she impressed upon the students. She spoke at length about the nurturing qualities of women who take care of their family and once educated the same women extend similar service at the workplace as well. She therefore emphasized the need for education which will lead to awareness of the rights of women.

The Resource Person of the first session Thiru K.Prabu, II Additional District Munsif, Puducherry deliberated upon Legal Rights of Women provided in the constitution of India, starting from civil rights to protection against violence against women, laws related to sexual harassment, dowry, and property rights. He impressed upon the students that as such constitution provides equal rights for women but it so happens that women and girls are unaware of their own rights which leads to the exercising of gender equity. This regional seminar he hoped will create the right kind of awareness in the students for further empowerment.

The Resource Person of the Second Session Thiru R.S.Zivanandam, Advocate, Puducherry, dwelled at length on Laws related to violence against women and remedies with regard to Acid attack . He advised the students to be careful and approach legal authority or the police when they feel threats of acid attack.

The next resource person of session III Tmt. V. Sofana Devi, District Judge as Member Secretary, Union Territory of Puducherry Legal Services Authority listed out the Role of Legal Services Authority relating to several women's issues including acid attack , domestic violence ,stalking, eve-teasing, and any other form of undesirable crime committed both at home and in public places. She also stated that first and 15<sup>th</sup> of every month the Legal services clinic organizes free counseling for students by appointing an advocate to give counseling to girls in trouble and also to enable them to execute their legal rights

concerning such issues. She also emphasized that UTPLSA take care for speedy implementation of legal process to resolve those issues.

Session IV- Interface Session included speakers like Thiru G. Sendilkumar, Secretary to Government (Law) Puducherry, Tmt. V. Sofana Devi, District Judge, Member Secretary, Union Territory of Puducherry Legal Services Authority, Thiru J.Selvanandhan, II – Additional District Judge, Puducherry and Thiru J.Dayalane,Tahsildar,Taluk Office, Puducherry Who deftly answered all queries raised by the student participants. It was a productive session with the girls coming up with issues related to personal issues, issues related to revenue office, property rights, molestation, rape and acid attack. The students were of the opinion that the punishment for the crime such as rape , acid attack must be made more severe and the criminals should never be pardoned. The speakers readily answered their queries and also offered to help them in any way and every way possible to find solutions to these issues through legal authority.

At the valedictory Dr.P.Poongavanam delivered the valedictory address and appreciated the work done by the staff members in creating a conducive atmosphere for the girls to have firsthand knowledge on their basic rights, problems related to women and the solutions.

The advisory Members of the seminar Dr. K.Subramani, RUSA Co-Ordinator, Dr.Josephine Nirmala Many, Head of the Department of Home Science, Dr. P.Nadesan, Head of the Department of Economics, Dr. S.Sahul Hameed , Assistant Professor of Corporate Secretaryship and offered their felicitations at the successful conduct of the seminar followed by students feedback , and certificate distribution.

Earlier Dr. S. Alamelu Mangai, Convenor & Organising Secretary of Seminar, and Chairman, Legal Services Clinic along with Coordinator, Co Co-ordinators Dr.L.Sucheta Soma Kirupa, Dr. Marie Joesphine Aruna and Organising Committee Members had made all arrangements for the regional seminar. .

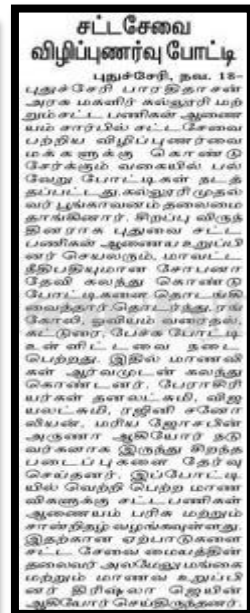

The clinic renders free legal services and counseling every 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of the month with the help of Mrs. Lavanya, Advocate from UTPLSA, Puducherry. Students grievances are being addressed personally and the remedies to be taken legally are also rendered.

The programme was conducted based on the Campaign devised by the National Legal Services Authority titled “Connecting to Serve”, with objectives to make weaker, marginalized sections of society aware of existence of Legal Service Institutions and availability of free legal services, legal service clinics, legal help line numbers and to identify those in need of legal assistance but have not taken resource to justice delivery system on account of economic or other disability , for 10 days from 9- 18 November 2017.

The days competition was presided by Dr. P.Poongavanam, Principal of the college and Tmt. V. Sofana Devi, District Judge and Member Secretary, Union Territory of Puducherry Legal Services Authority inaugurated the competition and felicitated the students.

**30.10.2019** – Legal Services Clinic of BGCW conducted a ONE DAY NATIONAL CONFERENCE on HUMAN RIGHTS PROTECTION-INDIAN SCENARIO in Hotel Athithi, Puducherry on October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

***Report on ONE DAY NATIONAL CONFERENCE on  
HUMAN RIGHTS PROTECTION -Indian Scenario on 30.10.2019***

A One Day National conference on “Human Rights Protection- Indian Scenario” was organized by the Legal Services Clinic of the college along with the Department of History , Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Bharathidasan Government College for Women and Union Territory Puducherry Legal Services Authority, Puducherry on the 30th of October in Hotel Athithi , Puducherry.

The Chief guests of the day’s programme were Hon’bleThiru Justice M. Jaichandren , Former Judge, High Court of Madras , Chairman Human Rights Committee Puducherry and Tmt. V.Sofana Devi , District Judge cum Member Secretary, Union Territory of Puducherry Legal Services Authority, Puducherry . The conference took a head start with the welcome address being given by Tmt. Mercy Thenmozhi, Head, Department of History. She welcomed the gathering consisting of chief guest, principal resource persons, professors, research scholars and students and delegates. The inaugural address was delivered by Dr.K.Subramani ,Principal ,BGCW. In his address he detailed on different rights relating to human protection with ancient histories and live examples and greeted the organizers for the effort and right topic chosen. Following which Dr. S.Gayathri , Assistant Professor , Dept Of Corporate Secretaryship, BGCW briefed the gathering on the theme of the conference.

The Keynote Address was delivered by Tmt.V.SofanaDevi , District Judge , Member Secretary UTPLSA where in the basic human rights and its provisions in the constitution were highlighted. Hon’bleThiru Justice M. Jaichandren , gave the Presidential Address which threw light on real life instances of violation of Human Rights .

The abstracts submitted by the researchers and faculty members from various institutions and universities were compiled as conference proceedings and were released .The full papers of the articles received from 54 scholars and faculty were reviewed and was published with ISBN No 978-93-89146-89-9 with the help of Shanlax Publishers. The book was edited by Dr.S.AlameluMangai, Chairperson LSC , Dr.S.Gayathri , Assistant Professor Department of Corporate Secretaryship and Dr.Sahul Hameed, Assistant Professor Department of Corporate Secretaryship.



The inaugural session came to an end with the Vote of Thanks being delivered by Dr.S.AlameluMangai ,Organising Secretary of Conference , Chairperson ,LSC, BGCW.

Followed by inaugural , the morning session commenced with Dr.R.R.Dhanapall ,Chairman IIPA as the resource person, for which Dr.S.Sahul Hameed ,Assistant Professor , BGCW and Dr.Marie Josephine Aruna , Chairperson LSC KanchiMamunivar Centre for Post Graduate Studies were the moderators. The topic for the session was ‘Role of NGOs in Advocacy for Human Rights’.

The Resource Person for the second session was Thiru.R.Karunanidhi , Advocate High Court at Madurai . The moderators were Dr.M.Geetha , Assistant Professor of History and Dr.P.Nallasamy , Chairperson, LSC, Tagore Arts and Science College.
